ADMISSION ASSESSMENT TESTING

- For consideration to the Fall (August) 2024 start date, last date to take the TEAS test is May 10, 2024
- For consideration to our Spring (January) 2025 start date, last date to take the TEAS test is November 15, 2024.
- **TEAS test scores required:**
 - A minimum Adjusted Individual Total Score of: TEAS 58.7% (Test must include all four categories)
 - A minimum Individual Reading score of TEAS 60.0%
- **TEAS** scores taken at other institutions are accepted.
- **TEAS** - offered at FHCT

APPLICATION DEADLINE for Spring 2025 is November 1, 2024; file completion deadline is November 15, 2024.

APPLICATION DEADLINE for Fall 2025 May 1, 2025; file completion deadline is May 15, 2025.

ADDITIONAL EXPENSE – LAST SEMESTER OF PROGRAM

- State Board License and NCLEX Exams (\$300)

REQUIRED CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

Scrubs as follows – EVERY DAY – INCLUDING the first day of class.

- **CLASS:** Scrub tops; – any color, hospital style
Lab Jackets – Navy, Burgundy, or Gray. **NO** hoodies, coats, etc.
Scrub Bottoms – any color, hospital style.
 - **CLINICAL/LAB:** Scrub Tops – Dark Gray (Charcoal, Pewter, Steel), hospital style.
Scrub Bottoms – Dark Gray (Charcoal, Pewter, Steel), hospital style.
Lab Jackets – Dark Gray. **NO** hoodies, coats, etc. (Clinical/Lab day clothing will be explained in class.)
 - Shoes – Nursing shoes or athletic shoes – MINIMAL color allowed. Toes and heels **MUST** be covered; no crocs or open-toed shoes allowed.
 - Socks – **MUST** be worn.
 - Bandage Scissors
 - Wristwatch – **MUST** have second hand AND twelve digits (numbers) on face of watch
 - Stethoscope
 - B/P Cuff – manual cuff
 - Pen Light
